



Practicums, Internships, and Residency (Associate License) Opportunities

Bachelor's Level – LAC

Internship Opportunity:

Hours: 20-30 hours a week (Unpaid) (What school requires)

Supervision: Supervision with a LMHC, LCAC OR LCSW

Program: LCAC, LMHC, LCSW

Duties:

- Assist with intakes and answering phones
- Assist with group work (multiple groups)
- Learn our program and assist with program development as needed
- By the end of internship leading groups by self
- Assist and learn to admit/discharge clients at residential
- Spend 2-3 days a week in residential facility.
- Learn treatment planning and note taking
- Learn overall operations of a residential facility
- Attend weekly supervision

Master's Level Students for LMHC, LCAC, LMFT, LCSW

Practicum Opportunity:

Hours: 10-15 hours a week (Unpaid)

Supervision: Supervision with a LMHC, LCAC OR LCSW

Program: LCAC, LMHC, LCSW, LMFT

Duties:

- Assist with intakes and answering phones
 - Assist with group work (multiple groups)
 - Learn our program and assist with program as needed
 - By the end of practicum leading group by self
 - Begin to counsel 1-3 residential clients for individual counseling
 - Counseling individual/couples/family clients based on school expectations.
 - Attend weekly supervision and clinical supervision group
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Internship Opportunity:

Time: 2 Semesters

Hours 15-20 hours a week (Unpaid)

Supervision: Supervision with a LCSW, LMHC, LCAC

Program: LMHC, LCAC, LCSW, LMFT

Duties:

- Hold a case load of 10-20 clients (individual, family, or couples)
 - Lead or assist in group work
 - Assist with taking assessments for mental health counseling, residency, and Intensive Outpatient.
 - Provide intakes for clients seeking individual, couple or family counseling
 - Weekly supervision
 - Weekly clinical staff meeting/supervision
 - Assist with IOP and/or creation of a group they provide.
 - Learn ways to begin to market themselves in the community.
 - Build a plan for after graduation and post-graduation goals.
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Residency/Associate License Opportunity:

Hours: 25-35 hours a week (Paid)

Supervision: With a LMHC, LCAC, OR LCSW

Program: Have associate license and completing hours needed to be fully licensed for LMHC, LCSW, LMFT, LCAC.

Duties:

- Caseloads of at least 20-25 clients
- Assist with leadership of practicum and interns
- Oversight of IOP's at different locations

- Provide assessments and intakes as needed.
 - Assist with leading development clinical monthly meeting
 - Supervision bi-weekly (begins weekly to begin with)
 - Assist with leading weekly clinical meeting
 - Create additional groups for families/couples
 - Assist with program development.
 - Provide work with our residential setting as needed.
 - Be part of the weekend on call team.
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To apply for a program, you will need to submit the following materials:

1. Counselor Preliminary Application.
 1. Letter of interest. Please describe your interest in applying for the practicum program at NewDay Center. Be sure to summarize any learning objectives/outcomes you desire from a counseling practicum.
 2. Testimony. Please write an account of your personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
 3. Signed Statement of Beliefs.
2. Proof of your current liability insurance. A copy of your policy with minimum coverage of \$1,000,000 (Individual) and \$3,000,000 (Aggregate). (For Master level students)
3. Include contact information for primary academic professor/supervisor.
4. Transcript of grades from graduate school thus far.
5. Current resume/vita.
6. Commitment to two semesters of internship following practicum, if offered by NewDay Center.

After your application has been received and reviewed, you will be notified regarding completing a background check and scheduling an on-site interview.

NewDay Belief Statement
